General Description:

The Safety Intern will support the Health & Safety, mining, milling and geology teams of the Eagle Mine and Humboldt Mill near Marquette, Michigan in developing and sustaining a safe, secure and healthful workplace for all employees and contractors.

Key Responsibilities:

- Provides support to the Health & Safety Team in championing zero harm
- Conducts surveys, studies, and audits to support workplace H&S
- Assists in the development of policies and procedures
- Conducts health and safety specific training for the mine and mill sites
- Compiles data necessary to complete internal health and safety performance reports
- Ensures effective implementation of the health and safety program at the Mine and Mill sites
- Assists with occupational health and industrial hygiene activities
