



Position: Environmental Analyst

Location: Eagle Mine, Upper Peninsula, Michigan, USA

General Description: This position is responsible for providing technical support for permitting, data management, and project-related tasks at the Eagle Mine and Humboldt Mill. This role will work in both the field and office settings, have the ability to carry out detailed assignments, synthesize large amounts of data, and must utilize excellent technical writing and verbal communication skills.

Key Responsibilities:

- Provide technical support to prepare permit applications for both the Eagle Mine and Humboldt Mill sites.
- Provide technical support in the design and/or execution of field programs, to support environmental compliance, environmental site improvements, mine closure, or related projects to understand and address environmental issues.
- Data collection, organization, management, and analysis.
- Prepares graphs, charts, and statistical models from synthesized data.
- Prepare internal and external reports for submission.
- Operate and maintain field monitoring equipment.
- Oversight of field contractors on environmental projects.
- Monitor operational and administrative compliance with Lundin Mining Responsible Mining Management System standards and programs, and support modes of compliance with local, state and federal environmental regulations.
- Provide day-to-day guidance on issues related to actual or potential environmental matters.
- Collaborate with other environmental professionals and experts in law to address environmental problems.
- Participate in the investigation of environmental incidents.
- Identify and analyze sources of pollution to determine their effects.
- Assist with employee training regarding site environmental issues and Eagle HSE Management System requirements.

Education, qualifications and experience:

- Requires a BS degree in Environmental Engineering, Environmental Sciences, or a related engineering discipline
- 2-4 years of experience in a related field preferred
 - Prefer candidates with knowledge of Michigan specific mine, water, air, land, wetland, and waste management acts, rules, regulations, and guidelines

- Knowledge of state and federal regulatory agencies environmental permitting and compliance practices and procedures is preferred
- ISO-14001 training experience is preferred
